As such I was asked to join and become CTO of 4 start-ups, Cotown B.V. (NL), Mobs Ventures (UK), Blender (IT) and Tohcan (UK). All are my current employers except Tohcan.

In 4 years in Cotown, I helped designed architecture, develop, and launch circular economy platform based on private block-chain networks, while training and managing 2 teams of 3 and 5 developers. In 7 years with Mobs Venture, I helped them develop, launch, and maintain various B2C platforms. In couple of years with Blender, I developed MVP, got a small grant, and currently have advanced talks with investors.

Present

My previous company was a purely customer orientated software development agency and as such I often felt lack of technical challenges, innovation, or real sense of contribution to society. Digital start-ups and SMEs are usually quite innovative; however, they lack tools to deliver their ideas to market and compete with big players. My idea was to develop AppsForce a modular platform as a service based on solutions from my old company. It had more than 40 modules, each one more complex and powerful than other. For example, one module was my version of Google Drive and Google Docs. Adding AI to analyse big data, truly understand the client's business and provide useful advice was my USP.

The idea was accepted in Brightlands Accelerator as one of 9 best ideas among over 800 that applied from all over the world. In 2017 I opened a Ltd company in London and in 2018 a B.V. in the Netherlands. I focused on 4 areas, social, health, energy, and agriculture.

In each sector I have won multiple grants from EU to develop the project and got customers from all over the Europe. There are literarily 1000s of people using AppsForce right now, either booking a restaurant in Croatia or finding their next job opportunity in the UK.

In the Agriculture I invented, designed, financed, and developed a product called Animus. We worked with partners such as Wageningen and Open Universities, TATA Consultancy and many others. We were collecting farm data from soil to satellites using combination of software and hardware. That data was analysed by our AI systems on AppsForce Cloud, and we offered farmers a specific advice how to maximise yield and minimise resources used. This project got various grants from LIOF, OostNL and DIL.

In Health we developed product for automating bacteria culture growth called Ovation, epilepsy seizure detection wearable device called Alpha Brain and 99% accurate medical encyclopaedia in Arabic based or our AI translation engine and source texts from our partner National Health Service of the United Kingdom. Each product was either for clients (NestEgg) or financed via grants (MIT, RVO). Alpha Brain was so successful that they got 4 million EUR to run clinical trials in April 2023.

In Social segment we developed Metaverse project for Italian and Spanish clients (Blender Worlds), as well as circular local economy for Heerlen Municipality (Herleen Heitje), SME Digitalisation Tools for Dutch Government and lastly social network for disadvantaged and disconnected youth in the UK (Slenky). Heerlen Heitje got 2 million EUR grant from Horizon 2020.

In the energy sector we developed a platform that saves electricity and heating by using AI that learns inhibitors behaviours and habits, and then fixes bad behaviour and teaches good one. In this product we were part of Tiorc consortium which was awarded 3 grants, developing electrical, heating, and cooling sensors as well as our software.

All these projects and many others are build using the same SaaS/PaaS platform AppsForce. I have proved that I can deliver a mind-blowingly complex platform with limited budget and fit it in the various markets.

I have started my company Codeten Ltd from my passion for development and mobile industry. I developed and published two games in the first year. In the following year we published three more releases.

During this time, I was approached by Research in Motion, and they invited me to join their team. I put the company on hold.

I have learned a lot from my time in Research in Motion and my entrepreneurial spirit led me to leave that company and resume my work in Codeten Ltd in 2011.

I have started with a small team, during the years it worked on more than sixty projects and developed more than hundred mobile applications, web sites, web applications and servers.

Our team now includes more than 40 top developers, designers, and other professionals. Our clients range from freelance photographers to global enterprises.

My role has changed from a founder and developer via project manager, head of mobile to the business director and strategist.
